ITEM DESCRIPTION: Discussion and possible action regarding Temporary Approval of a new Supper Club License subject to the provisions of the planning and fire codes and Health Dept. regulations, MP Partners-Summerlin, LLC, dba Makino's Sushi Seafoof Buffet & Lounge, 1225 Fort Apache Road, Masako Ishitsuka, Mgr, Mbr, Masashi Endo, Mgr, Mmbr, PAC Consulting, Inc, Managing Mmbr, 50%, Masashi Endo, Pres, Las Vegas Kitchen, LLC, Managing Mmbr, 50%, Masako Ishitsuka, Mgr, Mmbr - Ward 2 (Wolfson)

The applicants are requesting approval of a temporary license as provided by LVMC 6.06.051, which reads as follows:

- (A) City Council may grant a temporary license pending its decision regarding a license application in order to determine:
 - (1) The applicant's fitness for a license; and
 - (2) The appropriateness of the applicant's business location.
- (B) A temporary license shall not be granted under this Section unless:
 - (1) All principals required to be approved for suitability have submitted a complete investigation packet for determination of suitability and paid all applicable fees;
 - (2) The Director makes a preliminary finding that all of the principals of the business are suitable; and
 - (3) The applicant has submitted a completed and accurate license application and has paid all required application fees.

The attached letter dated July 5, 2006 from the applicant's outlines the request for a temporary license.

The applicants submitted all of the required documentation and paid all applicable fees for investigation on July 28, 2006. Based on a review of the SCOPE printouts furnished to this department by the applicants, we have determined that they are preliminarily suitable to hold a temporary supper club license until the investigation is complete.

In the event the Special Investigations Section, Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, should develop an area of concern with this applicant, this item will be brought back before the Council for appropriate action.
