NOTE: MAYOR GOODMAN disclosed that he is an honorary member of the V.F.W. Post, but he did not believe that would affect his ability to vote.

Minutes:

The applicant was present.

JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, indicated that six months ago four conditions were placed on this matter: 1) security be improved for the outside of the club, with alcohol prohibited in the parking lot; 2) lighting be improved in the parking lot; 3) staff be required to maintain appropriate alcohol, health and work cards; and 4) closing be no later than 9:30 p.m. for service and 10:00 p.m. for closing. MR. DiFIORE conceded that MR. YOUNG has made an effort to comply with the aforementioned conditions; however, as a matter of caution, he recommended extension of the temporary license, with the same conditions.

MR. YOUNG expressed concurrence with MR. DiFIORE'S recommendation, adding that he is trying.
