**Minutes:**

COUNCILMAN REESE noted the request to hold Item 98 [RQR-13791] in abeyance and he queried the reason. PAUL LARSON, 300 South Fourth Street, explained that there is a condition requiring a Final Inspection but providing documentation for this older building has been challenging. In order to produce the final documentation requested, he requested additional time to have a new inspection conducted.

COUNCILMAN REESE requested Item 108 [SUP-14687] be held in abeyance to the 10/18/2006 City Council meeting.

COUNCILMAN ROSS announced the applicant's request to hold in abeyance Item 92 [EOT-15236], Item 93 [EOT-15237] and Item 94 [EOT-15239] to the 9/20/2006 City Council meeting for an opportunity to meet with the applicant. ABRAM VELO appeared on behalf of the applicant and concurred with the request. MR. VELO requested that the associated Special Use Permits be extended in time to the same abeyance date. COUNCILMAN ROSS agreed.
