PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Las Vegas Veterans Parade Committee has requested \$25,000 in financial support from the city for the 2006 Veterans Parade (to be held on Saturday, November 11, 2006). Ordinance #5567 provides the City Manager authority to grant waivers of up to \$7,500 per parade in fees for city services; authority to act on requests exceeding \$7,500 or to provide other financial support in connection with a parade rests with the City Council.

For the 2005 Veterans Parade, the city approved a waiver of up to \$16,379. The city's contribution covered the city costs (streets cleanup, show mobile rental, and bleachers rental). Additional funding was also used to cover the cost for Metropolitan Police, barricade plan and some communications equipment rental.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the request by the Parade Committee with a funding amount of \$16,379 similar to the 2005 contribution.
