CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF: SEPTEMBER 20, 2006

JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, noted that business address should be Suites 110 and 115; they were not available at the time the matter was put on the agenda. He referred the Council to the police report provided by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (Metro), which indicates a concern with MR. ESTEY. However, the Nevada Gaming Control Board has made a disposition on MR. ESTEY, and the City is recommending approval of a temporary license to ensure that the conditions placed on MR. ESTEY by the Gaming Board are met.

ATTORNEY SCHRECK indicated that the remaining condition of the Gaming Board is the completion of an ethics course by MR. ESTEY. It was very difficult to enroll in an ethics course because most of them are offered as part of a graduate program. However, MR. ESTEY was able to register for a course in Portland, Oregon. He will be starting Tuesday, September 26, 2006.

MR. DiFIORE recommended the Council issue a temporary license, with authority granted to him to issue a permanent license upon satisfaction of completion of the ethics course by the Nevada Gaming Control Board.
