PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

At the regular scheduled Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission meeting held on September 13, 2006, the park naming subcommittee recommended a name for the 98,000 square foot community center located on 18 acres in Centennial Hills Park. Amenities include indoor and outdoor swimming pools, two gymnasiums, a senior center and space for a variety of multi generational activities. The center is located on North Buffalo Drive near Deer Springs Way. A vote by the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission was unanimous to recommend the name to City Council for review.
