GENERAL

PURPOSE:

Review all Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnership, and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) applications for funding and make recommendations to the City Council on those applicants that should receive funding.

AUTHORITY:

Created by City Council action on 1-8-1997 and members appointed on 1-8-1997.
(By-laws amended 12/15/99 to increase membership by four (4) members for a total of 31 members)(By-Laws amended 12/6/2000 to decrease term of office to six months) (By-Laws amended 8/15/2001 to reduce membership to 24 members) (By-Laws amended 7/20/2005 to increase term of office to nine months, to delete number of term limits, and to delete the specific areas of expertise of background designations.)

TERMS:

NINE MONTH TERMS No limit to number of terms. **NO FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE REQUIRED.**
(May fill unexpired term.) (Membership is not transferable or assignable)
(Initially, 14 members appointed for 2 yr. terms to insure continuity on the Board.)

MEMBERS:

24 members who reside or work in the City of Las Vegas appointed by the Mayor and City Council. Board members represent target neighborhoods and populations, including low-income, disabled, minorities, elderly and the community at large.
