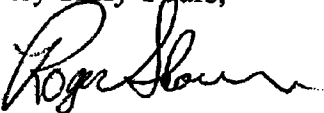

Dear Councilman Ross:

Please allow this correspondence to serve as my request for your support of the variance application that has been submitted on behalf of the Vitaly Scherbo School of Gymnastics. My daughter, Kaitlin, has been part of competitive gymnastics for the past five (5) plus years. During those five years her competitive spirit has grown tremendously. Unfortunately, for her to continue with her growth, and realize her dreams, it will be necessary for her to be a part of a state of the art facility. This is the facility that Vitaly Scherbo is attempting to build.

In order for Kaitlin to possibly obtain a gymnastics scholarship, or some of her team mates to even consider Olympic dreams, the Vitaly School of Gymnastics needs to expand its current gymnasium and include many state of the art apparatus. The plans would include a second story gymnasium to be utilized the competitive team gymnasts. Contrary to what some of the neighbors have claimed, the Vitaly School of Gymnastics' plans are not designed to increase the number of students it can enroll in the gym. Rather, the plans are designed to provide the current students what they need so that they can achieve their dreams.

Allowing the Vitaly School of Gymnastics to expand can only benefit the community's reputation. Moreover, the expansion will allow the current gymnasts, many of whom live within only a few miles of the gym, to remain at their current location, rather than force them to transfer to other gyms (such as Browns in the southwest valley, or Desert Gymcats in Henderson) that are

much further away from their homes. The proposed expansion will have no impact on the aesthetics of the community, as the gym is situated on a corner that currently houses a storage facility and a bank, and there is even a day care center across the street from the gym.

In the five plus years I have been driving my daughter to gymnastics I have never seen children running free in the streets or parking lots. I have never seen any of the gymnasts abuse any of the privileges they have of attending the Vitaly School of Gymnastics, nor have I observed any parents "speeding down Bronco" as have been alleged by only a few, but boisterous, residents. Since the expansion envisioned by the Vitaly School of Gymnastics is designed to benefit current students, the residents' concerns are not founded in fact, but in fiction.

In short, the proposed expansion will serve the community and the children of the community, not just the owners of the Vitaly School of Gymnastics. I would appreciate your support of the school's application when the time comes. Councilman Ross:

I am writing you in regards to an issue that is very important to me. I would like the city to vote favorably on the issue of the Vitaly Scherbo School of Gymnastics variance. First and foremost, it is a school, much like a dance or karate school where the parents drop the children off for class and then return to pick them up later. Over seventy-five percent of the parents do not park and watch. I bring my daughter five nights a week for as much as four hours per session and I park/watch. I am one of the few and have never seen the parking lot filled with cars having to park on the street. Many of the parked cars people see are from the veterinarian clinic or the staff at the Day Care Center on the corner. I often wait for my daughter by walking the neighborhood, talking to the horses, playing basketball at the Rainbow/Gowan Park, or frequenting the stores nearby. In over five years, I have watched the changes in the neighborhood for longer than some of the nearby residents have lived there.

I know there seems to be some issue about traffic congestion and vehicles speeding through up Bronco and it being blamed on the school parents. That could not be further from the truth. The speeders are external drivers, in no way related to the school, coming South from Jones/ Gowan and trying to beat the traffic. Bronco is one of the few streets that does not have a stop sign for its length and the locals know it. The local knowledge also allows drivers to cut through the Wells Fargo bank driveway and exit through the Vitaly Scherbo School parking lot, once again trying to beat the Cheyenne/Jones stoplight. The vast majority of the cars seen leaving the school premises are those illegal drivers.

I would like to now discuss the reasons it is important to allow the expansion and not worry about parking space count. I am not sure of the regulations on parking space requirements at schools but it can't be very many. I will use two analogies to illustrate my point. (Football) The school is catering to both the Varsity and Junior Varsity (or lower). The added room is to spread the players out onto two separate fields so each may have room to practice. It is not going to add more players onto both fields but keep the Varsity from running over the little JV's. (Horses) As some of the concerned homeowners probably have livestock I suggest that Mr. Scherbo is trying to have two corrals where he can teach Barrel Racing separated from Dressage. He also wants to provide stalls for the horses he has, not add more horses. Right now all the horses are

stuffed into one corral and the learning at the school is suffering. He just wants to spread his existing students out. This change should actually ease traffic as the times could change for the students to facilitate smoother drop offs.

Thank you for your time and attention to this very important matter. Please provide copies to your fellow councilmen / councilwomen as I would like to make my feelings know to all. I hope to have an opportunity to speak in front of the City Council at your convenience. Feel free to contact me at 702-596-6641.

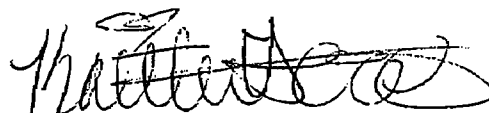

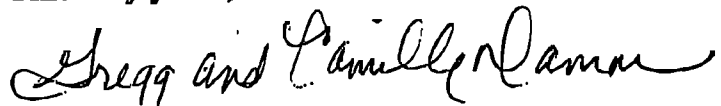

Dear Mayor Goodman and Las Vegas City Council:

I am the mother of two competitive team boys who have attended the Vitaly Scherbo School of Gymnastics for the past six years. I chose this particular facility because of Vitaly Scherbo, a six time gold medalist, in the sport of gymnastics. My oldest son has represented the State of Nevada for the past five years at the Regional Championships. I urge you to approve Mr. Scherbo's request to expand his facility which will only benefit the team. This structure will be used for training the competitive team members to further their careers. Some of these children spend more than 18 hours a week in the gym and they deserve a first rate workout area with top of the line equipment. That is what Mr. Scherbo proposes to do. His goal is to help all children who want to achieve a college scholarship reach their potential. He also wants to teach gymnastics in a happy and healthy environment and to further the careers of those who want to achieve it.

I have asked my fellow team parents, who wish to stay the two or three hours to watch their children, park in our back lot, most of who did not realize that it was our parking area. This will allow the recreational parents easier access to the facility. The staff has also been instructed to park in the back lot. We have also put up signs for all of our parents to please not park on the street. Our parents are more than happy to comply with anything we ask for the sake of their children.

As for the comments made by Mr. Leatham in a letter dated August 8, 2006, I find his statements to be unfounded. This street is not solely congested due to VSSG, but mainly to La Petite Academy pre-school on the corner of Bronco. None of their clients utilize the parking lot. They line both sides of the street during the busy hours of 4-6 p.m. Yes, this is a hazard for they load their children into the cars from the street and not the sidewalk. This, however, has nothing to do with our facility. As can be seen by the pictures presented by Mr. Leatham, most of which show an empty parking lot, this facility has more than enough parking. His pictures also show that a vehicle is able to go down the road even when cars are on both sides of the street.

Our facility's outside shrubbery is maintained and the area is very eye appealing. It does not disturb the appearance of the neighborhood in any way.

The traffic going up and down Bronco is primarily residents of that area. Every day many speed down the street and cut across our parking lot to exit to Jones, so that they do not have to wait at the light. On several occasions, some of our gymnasts were almost hit when walking to

their cars at night. If anything, we would greatly appreciate your attention to having local traffic not use the parking lot as a through way.

This facility is being built to further the careers of our children who are working so hard to achieve their dreams. For this, I ask that you please approve the proposed items.

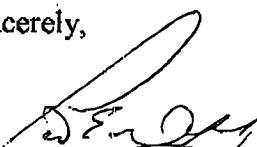
Honorable Mayor Goodman and Las Vegas City Council:

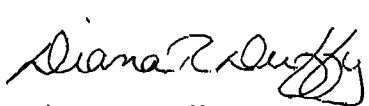

We have seen and been a part of many gyms both large and small in metropolitan cities such as Washington, D.C. and small towns such as Niceville, FL. Some of the most critical factors in finding a suitable gymnastic school are of course good coaches and quality equipment and facilities. Thank you for your time and attention. I am writing today to request that Vitaly Sherbo School of Gymnastic be allowed its second-story addition. I hope to address your concerns voiced at the last hearing on this topic.

Concern 1:

Parents are speeding down the street and parking on the street.

To enter our lot, one must slow down to make two quick turns. The speeders are those people entering our lot to get to Wells Fargo. Many are heading South on the street FROM THE NEIGHBORHOOD that is protesting this addition.

Those people parked on the street frequently are picking up kids from the day care on the corner. Mr. Sherbo recently posted signs and personally asked parents to move their vehicles when parked curbside.

Concern 2:

Expanding the gym causes a need for parking because of increased student enrollment.

That's not how this sport works. The addition to the physical gym WILL NOT significantly increase student enrollment. Families come to gyms because of the reputation of the instructors, not the facility. This sport is expensive, grueling, and time-consuming. Few people will join because of a bigger building THAT IS NOT VISIBLE FROM THE MAIN STREETS.

Mr. Sherbo is increasing the size of the gym to improve his ability to train his students, not his profit margin. My 4 children who train there will benefit from the addition because they will be allowed more space in which to train, a better student-teacher ratio with the division of EXISTING classes, and the ability to train simultaneously. Our tuition will go up to pay for the addition. It will not be lowered because of new students. Money spent on my kids is well worth it for me and our community.

Concern 3:

If it's not for money, why expand?

Mr. Sherbo can host meets if he has a larger gym. Meets aren't money-making ventures. Hopefully, the hosting gym breaks even, but the point is to offer the hosting parents an opportunity to earn money to subsidize their children's tuition and to get the gym's name out in the national arena. They run on the weekends when tourism in Las Vegas is slow and hotels like the Texas, Fiesta, and Santa Fe can benefit from the business.

Neighborhoods win when meets are hosted because of the increase in family-oriented tourism. Our local kids win because college coaches attend and recruit for the all-too-

elusive college scholarship. Furthermore, both the daycare and the recreational classes are closed during meets, so parking is not an issue.

An ongoing observation I have made, however, is that the gymnastics floor becomes quite crowded at certain times of the day and week. Male and female gymnasts currently must share the same workout space. Thus, inevitably, there are times when there's simply not enough physical space for all the gymnasts to do what they need to do.

When I heard about the proposed expansion, I thought it was wonderful. The intent of the additional space to be built over the existing parking area seemed to be a perfect solution for these issues. The intent behind the expansion is to separate the female gymnasts from the male gymnasts, giving both more room to complete their workouts. The female gym was to be the new area over the existing parking area. The male gym would remain the same.

I was surprised to hear that Mr. Scherbo's request to allow the expansion was up for denial. My understanding is that the denial is based on there being "too few parking spaces to support the use". My understanding is the expansion is intended to better serve the gymnasts who attend now, not to increase greatly the number who attends in the future. Therefore, the parking available now is perfectly adequate. No additional parking is needed. The parking lot may be busy as one practice ends and another begins, but I've always been able to park my car in the lot.

I might add that this school, like other schools, has a fairly static number of "students". This is not a 24 Hour Fitness where there are thousands of members and you never know how many people are going to show at a given time. The same groups of children come and go on the

schedules given them by their coaches. They show up when expected because they are responsible athletes, dedicated to their sport. They are not the wild hooligans described by homeowners who live in the area.

I would ask the Council to approve the items requested by Vitaly Scherbo to allow the growth of these child athletes.

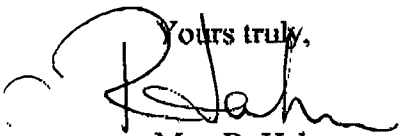

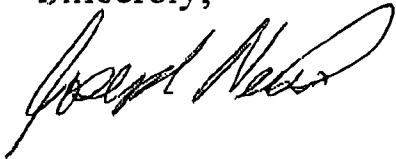

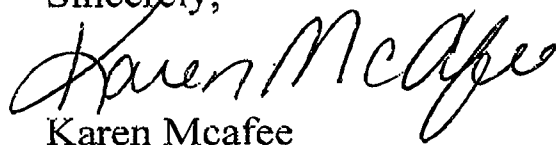
With an added addition, it will give the instructors and the students much more room to do so much more.

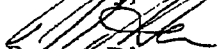
