**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

Discussion and possible action regarding Temporary Approval of a Six-Month Review of a Supper Club License.

On February 28, 2006 Mr. DiFiore received a letter to request a temporary supper club alcohol license for Ajuua Mexican Restaurant and Cantina.

On April 3, 2006, we received a copy of a letter addressed to Mayor Oscar Goodman from Moran & Associates referring Ajuua Mexican Restaurant & Cantina, and the sole owner/operator Daniel Cardenas. This letter was to inform us that Daniel Cardenas was arrested for the charge of DUI Driving Under the Influence (1st Offense) the week prior to April 3, 2006.

On April 19, 2006, Ajuua Mexican Restaurant and Cantina was issued a 6 month temporary license which expires October 19, 2006. On August 22, 2006 Business Services received the Investigative report prepared by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police which will be provided to the City Council in their investigative book.
