Minutes:

TOM AMICK, Attorney, Kummer Kaempfer Bonner Renshaw and Ferrario, appeared representing the applicant.

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JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, indicated that the applicant met the criteria for consideration of temporary approval. He suggested approval as recommended, along with a six-month review. ATTORNEY AMICK concurred with the conditions as recommended.

MR. DiFIORE interjected that the application was submitted with a wine-cordial and liqueur tasting license, which was inadvertently omitted from the subject of the agenda summary page; therefore he asked the City Attorney if the application could be amended to include the wine cordial and liqueur tasting request. CITY ATTORNEY JEBBIC advised that the subject could not be amended at this time, as the license types are traditionally specifically stated on the agenda; therefore, the application is limited to the license type specified on the agenda. ATTORNEY AMICK indicated he would have no problem returning before the Council regarding the omitted license request.
