PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The "Property Owners' Bill of Rights" initiative proposes to amend Article I of the Nevada Constitution to restrict the exercise of eminent domain. The initiative will have a detrimental effect on taxpayers, motorists, businesses, and homeowners. In particular, the initiative will negatively affect development of highways, roads, floor control projects, water and sewer facilities, and other essential public work projects.
