MAYOR GOODMAN recognized and presented HARLEY LaMAY with a proclamation. MR. LaMAY, a Las Vegas resident, celebrated his 100th Birthday and has been a resident of Las Vegas since 1965. In 1930 he learned to fly and bought his own plane. Since he was too old to serve during World War II, he obtained an age waiver and served as a flight instructor at Ryan Field in Arizona. He was also a helicopter flight instructor during the Vietnam era. MR. LaMAY has been very active in the community, serving on committees such as the state Commission for the Aging. After retiring, he helped build the senior center in Pahrump.

MR. LaMAY thanked the Mayor and Council and stated his secret to a long life and success is hard work and clean living.
