**Whereas;** Harley moved to Las Vegas in 1965; and

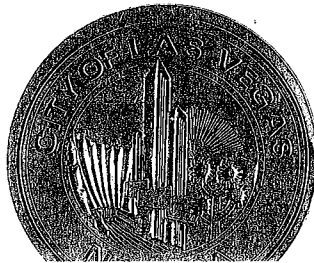
**Whereas;** Harley served on the State of Nevada Commission on Aging during
