**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

On February 5, 2003 City Council approved the award of Contract No. 050542-DD to provide engineering design services of the Tenaya Way Overpass at Summerlin Parkway. This modification adds drainage system design improvements at the intersection of Tenaya Way and Washington Avenue, provides details for relocating the Southwest Gas line into the bridge and repackaging the Tenaya Way and construction support services documents. These services are exempt from the competitive bidding process pursuant to NRS 332.115.1(b), Professional Services.
