INVOCATION, REVEREND CYNDI DeLONG, RELIGIOUS SCIENCE

Minutes:
REVEREND CYNDI DeLONG, Religious Science, gave the invocation.

COUNCILMAN BRESI outlined the history of this application and emphasized that the site is a challenging infill project. He detailed how the applicant revised the proposed development to alleviate the residents' concerns. He was not aware of the Parent/Teacher Association (PTA) regulating student population in elementary schools; it was reviewed and verified by the Clark County School District that Earns Morley Elementary School could in fact handle the population. He pointed out that he counted 96 signatures of opposition, with some being duplicates, to the 68-unit project. He was displeased by a comment made indicating this type of project results in increased crime and does not belong in single family neighborhoods. However, he strongly believed that the proposed development is an opportunity to fill the parcel and create homes with reasonable price points for others to live in. The Councilman concluded by saying he appreciated the residents meeting with the applicant and commended all who participated in listening and addressing the residents' concerns.
