COUNCILMAN ROSS recognized National Geographic Information Systems Day, noting that it is appropriate to recognize technology and its importance, because it is helping to make government more efficient. To help promote awareness of GIS systems, the City will partake in the Seventh Annual GIS Day held around the world, and staff from the Department of Information Technologies will be making presentations at various schools.

COUNCILMAN ROSS called forward JOSEPH MARCELLA, Director of Information Technologies, and RICHARD WELLS, Senior GIS Analyst, and presented MR. MARCELLA with a Proclamation and declared November 15, 2006, Geographic Information Systems Day in the City of Las Vegas.

MR. MARCELLA noted that approximately 15 years ago the communities decided that the Las Vegas area is one valley and that all entities should be included on a single map and a single database, which increases safety and benefits the economy and this fast-growing community.
