

PETITION TO THE LAS VEGAS CITY COUNCIL

We the undersigned endorse dedicating Huntridge Circle Park to the veterans of our country and that it be renamed "Veterans Memorial Park" in their honor.

Because the current configuration of Huntridge Circle Park allows unlimited ingress/egress on all quadrants, we believe an 8 ft. fence should be erected around 360 degrees of the perimeter that limits access to a maximum of two narrow entrances that can be blocked if a crime occurs.

We believe that most persons who commit crimes in our parks are ex-convicts who would not feel comfortable behind any fence that limits their ability to flee in the event police or marshals respond.

We believe that the current bathrooms in Huntridge Circle Park are unnecessary and counterproductive and should be removed to make way for memorials and monuments in respect to our armed forces.

We believe that the police must be encouraged to enforce all current laws in city parks, and we support the fixed base social service agencies that help truly homeless persons wanting or requiring assistance.
