**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The project primarily includes overlaying the existing asphalt pavement with 1-inch UTACS Surfacing on St. Louis Avenue from Paradise Road to Maryland Parkway. The construction work also includes concrete median islands, street lights, signing, striping and adjustments of existing utility facilities and minor traffic signal upgrades.

The apparent low bidder Southern Nevada Paving has requested approval to withdraw their bid of \$1,933,711.50 due to an error within their bid. Their bid did not include a cost for line item 403.01, UTAC Overlay a major cost item for this project valued at over \$250,000.
