PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Project will consist of the construction of pedestrian enhancements which include sidewalk bulb-outs, mid-block pedestrian crossings with landscaping and decorative and directional signage, gateway arches, removal and installation of new curb, gutter, sidewalk, streetlights, and related traffic signalization and drainage improvements.
