No motion required. A presentation was made.

COUNCILMAN BROWN announced that in 1995, the Regional Flood Control District was created to master plan for flood control in order to protect property and lives. For the past 20 years, the District has done a wonderful job, but mother nature is unpredictable; therefore, it is important to raise the awareness level, especially for new residents coming to the Valley. Well over \$1 billion has been spent in drainage and channels, but there is still much to be done.

COUNCILMAN BROWN called forward GALE FRASER, Director, Clark County Regional Flood Control District, along with the Regional Flood Control Board members, and presented MR. FRASER with a Proclamation declaring the month of July 2006 to be Flash Flood Awareness Month.

MR. FRASER stated that it is important to keep people away from floods and for people to not drive through water if they cannot see the road.
