The applicant, YUE DAI, was present, accompanied by ALEX YOUNG, interpreter.

JIM DiFIORE, Manager, Business Services, indicated that there are no areas of concern. The applicant was approved a temporary license approximately six months ago, with the condition that the previous owners not be involved in or be allowed on the premises of the business. There is, however, a change in the business operation. The business is now being sold to another party, who is currently under investigation for consideration at a future date by the Council. He recommended extension of the temporary license, with the conditions, allowing investigation of the new owner to conclude.
