This bill will amend Ordinance No. 5847, adopted on August 16, 2006, to delete certain provisions related to the establishment or maintenance of sleeping quarters within five hundred feet of any deposit of urine or feces. It has been determined that those provisions are inconsistent with the stated purpose of Ordinance No. 5847, and that any consideration of the issue should take place separately.
