Bill No. 2006-54 Prohibits unruly gatherings and establishes regulations and penalties with respect thereto. Sponsored by Councilwoman Lori Tarkanian

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will prohibit unruly gatherings and provide regulations and penalties with respect thereto. Such gatherings include neighborhood games and other gatherings in residential areas that cause a disturbance of the quiet enjoyment of private or public property. Typical gatherings of this type involve the consumption of alcoholic beverages by minors and create the need for emergency response services. This bill is intended to reduce the costs of providing such services by providing for civil penalties and the recovery of costs.

RECOMMENDATION:

This bill should be submitted to a Recommending Committee for review, hearing and recommendation to the City Council for final action.
