BEATRICE TURNER, West Las Vegas resident, urged the City to ensure that future senior housing projects include safe bathrooms that are equipped with appropriate fixtures.

ROXANNE LEWIS attempted to speak about and show pictures about a beating that took place in the area of Walnut and Harris; however, CHAIRMAN GOODMAN advised her that the intersection of Walnut and Harris is located in North Las Vegas and that the incident is not relative to redevelopment matters.

JAMES LEWIS, Civil Rights Attorney, insisted on speaking about the beating in North Las Vegas, as well as other incidents involving Metro, but CHAIRMAN GOODMAN advised him that it would not be appropriate.

JERRY M. NEAL, President of the Marble Manor Resident Council, thanked MEMBER ROSS, as well as CHAIRMAN GOODMAN and MEMBERS WEEKLY and WOLFSON for their efforts with the Las Vegas Housing Authority to improve public housing, but noted that issues remain. Also, he commented that West Las Vegas must have a major grocery store in order to grow.
