This bill will update Title 11 of the Municipal Code, relating to the regulation of traffic and parking. Most of the updates are minor and clarifying in nature. The bill does include an increase in the fine amounts for parking a vehicle in certain prohibited locations, and adjusts the provisions relating to parking exemption permits.
