MS. LIDDLE remarked that she also runs an upper-class establishment.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN asked if the beauty salon has been in operation and MS. LIDDLE wishes to add the massage service. MS. LIDDLE clarified that both uses have been in operation. MR. VINCENT rejoined that the applicant is seeking approval of the transfer of the massage license. COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN noted that she wanted to make that clear, because her constituents always become concerned when it comes to massage establishments.

COUNCILMAN REESE confirmed that there are 26 licensed beauticians, with one of them also licensed as a massage therapist, and an additional massage therapist.
