Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open.

JAMES GRINDSTAFF, 9440 West Sahara Avenue, represented the applicant and concurred with the conditions as recommended. They coordinated with the Las Vegas Valley Water District on the type of landscaping and the area of turf to be removed. They have been able to increase the turf area to 12,000 square feet, which will be removed from the original 8,000 square feet. There are four fountains on the site; one large fountain sits on the main entry, one near the Cheesecake Factory, one in front of Wild Truffles, and another in front of a retail store. The removal of the turf is expected to be completed in a couple of weeks and the fountains

should be operating at that time.
