Proclamation




- WHEREAS;* Dr. Emil Frei III is a world renowned oncologist who has dedicated over fifty (50) years of service to medical research, clinical practice and education to become a pioneer and a leader in the field of chemotherapy and cancer research; and
- WHEREAS;* Dr. Frei's distinguished career includes top medical leadership positions. He served as Chief of Medicine at the National Cancer Institute in Maryland and as a Professor and Associate Scientific Director Head at M.D. Anderson; he also served as the Director and Physician-in-Chief at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, where he is currently Physician-in-Chief, Emeritus; and is now Richard and Susan Smith Distinguished Professor of Medicine at Harvard; and
- WHEREAS;* he wrote the first comprehensive textbook incorporating principals and practice in Cancer Medicine; which is now in its seventh edition; and
- WHEREAS;* through the use of chemotherapeutic agents in combination, he demonstrated that a cure could be achieved against leukemia and Hodgkin's disease; and
- WHEREAS;* after retiring from a full-time practice, Dr. Frei now lectures, writes and consults and actively works with various medical groups and community groups in Las Vegas, Nevada, where he and his family have made their home; and
