At the request of CITY MANAGER SELBY, CITY ATTORNEY JERBIC updated the Council on the FAA right-hand-turn issue. At the conclusion of a scheduled meeting with the mediator that afternoon at 4:00 p.m., City Attorney staff would be able to determine whether the City should submit to mediation or pursue a lawsuit. COUNCILMAN WOLFSON asked if daily status updates could be made available to the public, to which CITY ATTORNEY JERBIC answered that concerned citizens could contact his office for information.

CITY MANAGER SELBY reported that the City received a grant for over \$400,000 for the Post Office Museum. The Vegas Grand Prix preparations are underway. DR. BARBARA JACKSON, Director of Leisure Services, was recently named Administrator of the of the Year for her involvement with Black Public Administrators. The annual budget workshop is scheduled for March 14, 2007, in Council Chambers, to present the preliminary budget. The Mutts and Masters 5-K Run is coming up at the Veterans Memorial Leisure Center.
