PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The existing monopine at this location was constructed and designed by Cingular Wireless with the purpose of accommodating future collocations. T-Mobile will add twelve antennas to the trunk of the existing pole and will construct an equipment shelter and security fencing. T-Mobile shall pay the City a one-time administrative fee of \$1,000 and the yearly rent will start at \$18,000. The initial term is for five years with three, five-year options.
