Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open on Items 110 and 111.

LARRY BUZBEE, Civil Works, appeared on behalf of the applicant and showed aerial photos of the subject site and the adjacent sites, which included the Lamplight Glen residential gated community and historical horse properties.

Although MR. BUZBEE'S presentation was nice, COUNCILMAN REESE sought clarification relative to the photos shown.

CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF: March 21, 2007

Although COUNCILMAN ROSS appreciated MR. BUZBEE'S presentation, he agreed that it was somewhat vague. To assist Council, COUNCILMAN ROSS verified with MR. BUZBEE that the applicant's desire is to build four, 2-story homes on 20,000 square foot lots, with a private gated street. The Councilman supported the applicant's request, as he was familiar with the project and comfortable with the proposal. He also appreciated and supported the applicant's efforts in building fabulous half-acre homes in the northwest area.

TOM McGOWAN concurred with COUNCILMAN ROSS' comments and felt the presentation was credible. He asked the Council to approve the application.

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing closed on items 110 and 111.
