

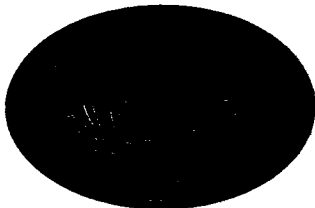
From the office of the Mayor
