

## **CONDITIONS**

- 1. No person who was associated as a defendant, including Frederick Rizzolo, in U.S. District Court cases 2:06-cr-186-PMP-PAL, 2:06-cr-188-PMP-PAL, CR-S-05-0017-KJD(LRL) shall be permitted on the premises of the business. The defendants, including Frederick Rizzolo are further prohibited from operating, controlling, or participating in any way with the operation of the business.**
- 2. No person associated with the ownership of the Power Company, Inc, nor its management, including Annette Rizzolo Patterson – the bookkeeper, Frederick Rizzolo or Bartholomew Rizzolo shall be permitted on the premises of the business. Further Frederick Rizzolo, Bartholomew Rizzolo, and Annette Rizzolo Patterson are further prohibited from operating, controlling, or participating in any way with the operation of the business, however, for the first seven days after the issuance of the license, Bartholomew Rizzolo and Annette Rizzolo Patterson may assist licensee for the limited purpose of turning over control of the business from the Power Company, Inc. to licensee.**
- 3. Photographs and names of the prohibited persons in special conditions 1 and 2 shall be made available to all individuals responsible for the operation of the business in order that the business complies with special condition 1 and 2.**
- 4. The agent appointed by the landlord under Section 23 of the operating sublease must receive prior approval by the Business Licensing Manager and licensee shall notify the Business Licensing Manager in advance of any on-site visits by the landlord's agent.**
- 5. Any violation of these conditions or special conditions or any violation of any local, state or federal law shall allow the Business Licensing Manager to administratively suspend the liquor license. Licensee understands that he has a right to appeal the suspension at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, subject to the open meeting law.**
- 6. No person related by blood or who has ever been related by marriage to Rick Federick Rizzolo shall be employed or allowed on the premises of the business.**
- 7. No person related by blood or marriage, or former marital status, to any defendant in the federal cases mentioned in Condition 1 can be employed or allowed on the premises of the business.**
- 8. Neither the licensee or anyone associated with him may communicate in any fashion with Rick Rizzolo or anyone associated with him about the operation of Crazy Horse Too.**

- 9. Licensee must close escrow for the purchase of the property commonly known as the Crazy Horse Too by June 30, 2007.**
- 10. Any and all funds used to purchase the Crazy Horse Too shall be verifiable and subject to the approval of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. Licensee shall provide all financing documents, as well as all escrow documents, to the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department upon request.**
- 11. Condition 5 is superceded by the following condition:**

**Licensee stipulates and agrees that the Business Licensing Director shall have the power to summarily suspend any City business license related to this property upon his finding of any substantial violation of law or conditions of licensure, which make such a suspension, in his sole discretion, necessary.**

**The only restriction upon his ability to exercise this power shall be the condition that he will deliver a written notice of his intention to do so at least 24 hours in advance of his action and allow licensee an opportunity to be heard, informally, in opposition.**

**If the Business Licensing Director summarily suspends any privileged license, it is part of this stipulation that he will promptly initiate the formal disciplinary process set forth in our code for the City Council to consider whether or not to impose discipline.**

- 12. Licensee shall reimburse the cost of the investigation to the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department.**
