**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

Scotch 80's Limited possesses a Tavern License (L16-00128-4-000190), Gaming License (G01-02175-4-000314) and other non-privilege related licenses. At the August 16, 2006 City Council meeting Council approved six conditions to add to the license of Squiggys, one of which they were required to sell the business within a six month period or the licenses would be automatically revoked. Scotch 80s could appeal to Council for an extension of this time period if they have a signed sales agreement with a deposit in escrow, an application for transfer of ownership filed with Business Services, and a new gaming application filed with State Gaming and Business Services when the six month term expires while the investigations on the alcohol and gaming licenses are being completed.
