**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

The Regional Transportation Commission is planning to relocate the transit functions and activities of the existing Downtown Transportation Center located adjacent to City Hall at the intersection of 4th Street and Stewart Avenue. The new facility is to be constructed on a City block located at the intersection of Bonneville Avenue and Casino Center. The RTC has asked that the City Council express its intent to support relocation of the facilities by resolution, in that such relocation is instrumental in the continued development of the downtown office core.
