JIM DiFIORRE, Manager of Business Services, stated that the applicant met the criteria to be considered for temporary approval. He suggested approval, with the same conditions, which he outlined, imposed on the Special Use Permit: 1) The hours of operation shall be limited to 10:00

a.m. to 10:00 p.m.; 2) Alcohol sales shall be conducted only in conjunction with food service; and 3) The temporary license shall be for a maximum period of 120 days.

WILLIAM URGA, Attorney, Jolley, Urga, Worthwood, Berry and Standish, appeared on behalf of Wolfgang Puck Catering and requested approval. He stated the owner hopes to be able to resolve some of the outstanding issues within 120 days, so that proper banquet facilities can be offered. COUNCILWOMAN TARKANTIAN emphasized that this license is temporary, pending a text amendment that will put this business in the desired supperclub/restaurant category. She mentioned that she enjoyed the peek-a-boo; the food was delicious.
