PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The city of Las Vegas Planning and Development Department is applying for designation as a Preserve America Community. Preserve America is a White House initiative developed in cooperation with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) and the U.S. Departments of the Interior, Commerce, Agriculture, and Housing and Urban Development.

Preserve America Community designation is granted to eligible communities that have met certain criteria. One criterion is that the governing body of the community has adopted a resolution indicating its commitment to the preservation of its heritage assets.

The benefits of becoming a Preserve America Community include eligibility for Preserve America grants (up to \$150,000 annually), among other promotional benefits such as authorization to use the Preserve America logo on signs, flags, banners, and promotional materials, listing in a Web-based Preserve America Community directory, inclusion in national and regional press releases, official notification of designation to State tourism offices and visitor bureaus, and enhanced community visibility and pride.
