Minutes:

CITY MANAGER SELBY reported on the various events occurring throughout the City. The Public Works Department will soon complete the Centennial Hills Community Center, road improvements to Cheyenne Avenue between Rampart and US-95, beautification of St. Louis Avenue, softball complex at Alexander and Hualapai and the East Fremont Entertainment District. Additionally, the City will take over ownership, operations and maintenance of Floyd Lamb Park at Tule Springs.

CITY MANAGER SELBY noted that during activities at Doolittle Community Center there were some acts of violence that caused a great deal of concern to the patrons and employees of the center. Hence, staff has been actively working with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Neighborhood Services, Detention and Enforcement and Leisure Services to address the issues with possible measures. To create a safer environment, a full-time marshal has

been placed at Doolittle and the lights in the ball field are being kept on throughout the night.

On June 28, 2007, a naturalization ceremony, which the Mayor will partake in, will take place in the Council Chambers. Also, the July 4, 2007, Council meeting will be held on July 11, 2007, due to the Fourth of July Holiday.
