Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open.

JULISSA COBOS, Radsa, Inc., appeared and stated they have been in business for eight years. Last year, there was a fire in their neighbor's property, which caused damage to their property.

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The reconstruction process exceeded the allotted time on their special use permit, thereby it cancelled. Their business license is current, and she requested approval of this special use permit.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW stated that the proprietors run a very good operation. He supported their request and looked forward to them continuing their service to the community.

MARGO WHEELER, Director of Planning and Development, commented that staff is working on a text amendment to extend the time period on special use permits. It generally takes longer than six months to reopen a business after a hardship, such as this one, occurs.
