Minutes:

CITY MANAGER SELBY reported that cooling stations were set up during the recent heat wave to prevent heat-related fatalities. Additionally, City marshals disseminated water bottles in parks. COUNCILMAN WOLFSON asked if the County had a similar program. DEPUTY CITY MANAGER SANCHEZ replied that the City of Las Vegas, Clark County, the City of Henderson and the City of North Las Vegas worked in conjunction with the Southern Nevada Homeless Coalition.

CITY MANAGER SELBY continued and indicated that the City would be accepting applications for the Citizens Academy through July 31, 2007; they can be obtained through the website and the City Manager's office. MAYOR GOODMAN noted that it is a wonderful program that all participants have raved about.

At the request of COUNCILMAN REESE, CITY MANAGER SELBY advised that a bus route would be instituted to expand service to downtown. This is in response to a citizen's concern. The new route will be evaluated at the conclusion of six weeks to see if it is worth keeping.
