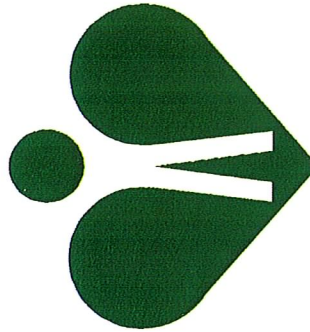

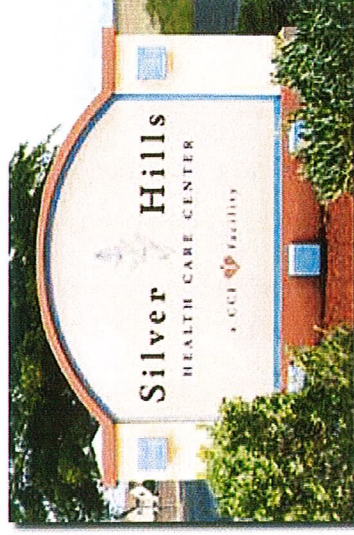

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Rehabilitation

Silver Hills is proud to present our Homeward Bound Program. The focus of our program is on short term rehabilitation. We have a rehabilitation unit in our skilled nursing facility with Neurological, Respiratory, Physical and Orthopedic based programs. Our therapy team is made up of physical, occupational and speech therapists. Each patient's rehab is set up to address the specific needs of the individual; treatment time may vary from thirty minutes to three hours for individual and/or group sessions, on a daily basis. We also provide follow-up services at our outpatient therapy program at Silver Hills.

Silver Hills Health Care Center provides the finest level of rehabilitation services consistent with the philosophy of meeting the needs of those we serve. We provide individualized treatment programs which allow residents to reach their maximum independence level. Family involvement in the rehabilitation process is encouraged. We believe that the family support and education are vital aspects in providing excellence in care and assisting the patient to maximize functional ability and independence.

Physical Therapy Services focus on identification, prevention and rehabilitation of individuals with physical impairment and pain. Following evaluation, the Physical Therapist develops an individualized treatment program addressing the areas of lower extremity strength, balance, coordination, functional movement, ambulation, endurance and general mobility.

Occupational Therapy Services address activities of daily living skills, including eating, dressing, hygiene and home management tasks, as well as upper extremity functioning, cognition and perception. The Occupational Therapist assists the patients in achieving their highest level of functioning, and in maximizing independence.

Speech/Language Therapists provide a continuum of services including assessment, education and treatment of patients with communication, cognition and swallowing problems. Treatment programs are directed towards improving communication skills in the area of comprehension and expression. Patients admitted to the facility that are receiving nutrition partially or exclusively via a gastrostomy tube are evaluated for their potential to return to solid foods as appropriate.

The patient and family are important members of the team, and are directly involved with the establishment of a personalized treatment program that meets each patient's needs and goals. The rehabilitation program is coordinated with all services offered at Silver Hills Health Care Center in order to facilitate functional improvement and to promote self-sufficiency.

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Survey Ratings

Every Skilled Nursing facility (SNF) is required to operate within a strict set of guidelines and regulations from the Bureau of Licensure and Certification (BLC). To determine compliance, every SNF is visited unannounced by a group of BLC personnel whose responsibility includes methodical inspections of the facility, or of needed, extended investigations of activities that may demonstrate irregularities outside of a normal SNF operation. This visit is called a "survey" or a State Inspection.

Depending on the severity of deficiency findings from the "survey", a Skilled Nursing Facility can be cited, penalized and required to comply, or to the extent of the law, may be ordered to cease operations.

We are proud of our survey results and you will find them posted throughout the facility. For the years 2004 and 2005 Silver Hills achieved Deficiency Free State Surveys.

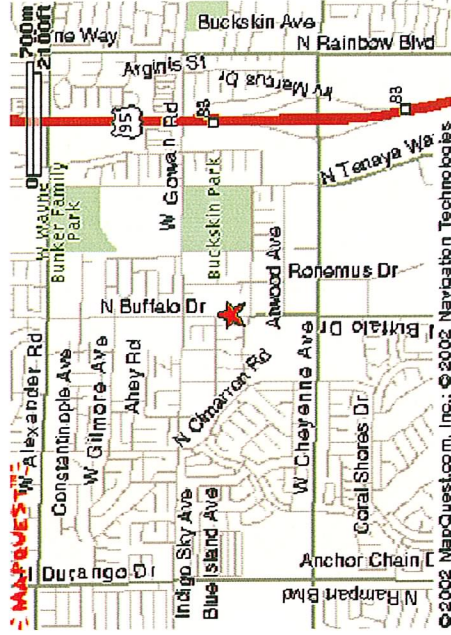

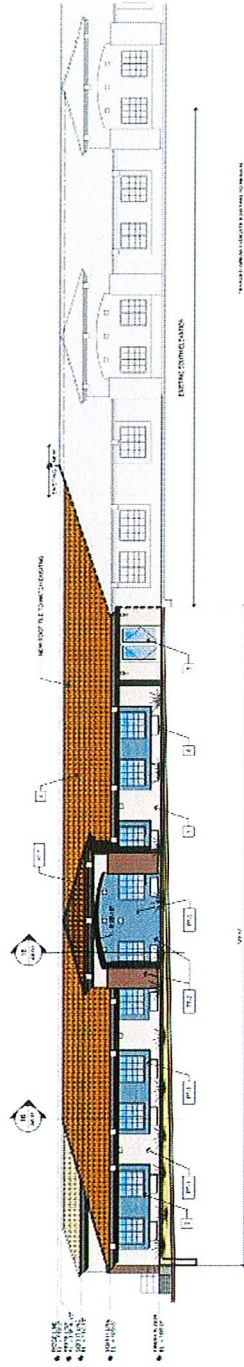

Proposed Expansion

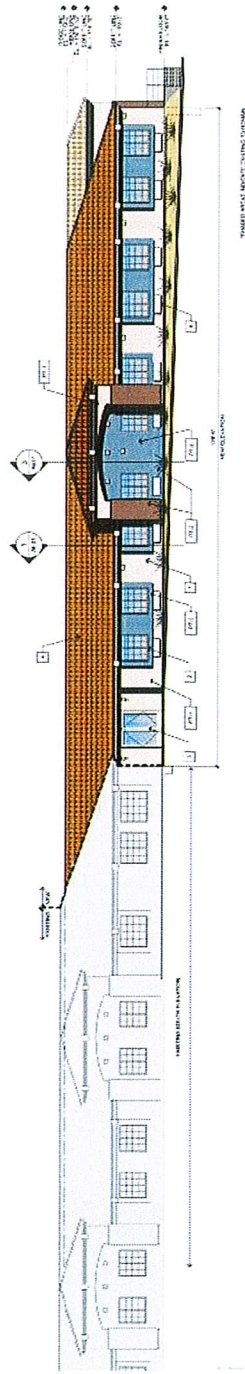
- ❑ Silver Hills is proposing to add a “Specialty Rehabilitation Unit” focused on meeting the needs of younger Medicare/Managed Care patients who need short-term rehabilitation therapy and are looking for specialty units that are separate from the long-term residents.
- ❑ The “Specialty Rehab Unit” will consist of 36 beds, a rehabilitation gym and separate dining facility.
- ❑ In addition the “Specialty Rehab Unit” will have the capability to providing outpatient rehabilitation services to residents within the community who require therapy services but do not require 24-hour nursing services.
- ❑ The addition will be located on what is currently a vacant dirt lot situated behind the existing facility.
- ❑ Silver Hills consistently sustains an average census of 112 residents out of 118 beds for occupancy of 95%.

Proposed Expansion

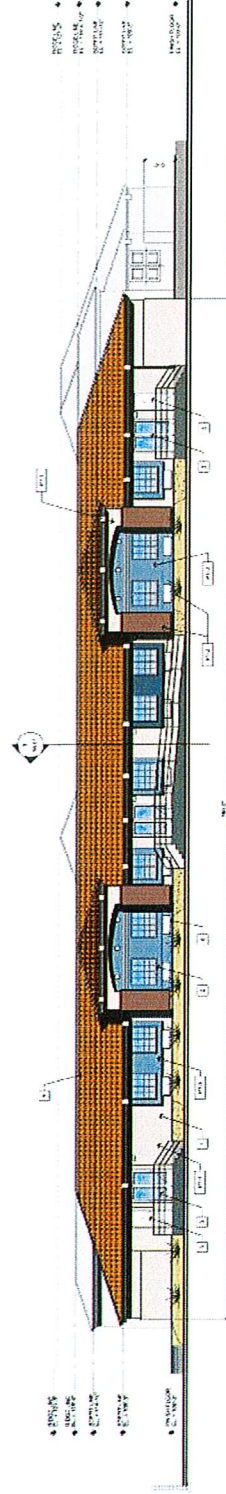
- ❑ Covenant Care's Silver Ridge facility consistently sustains average census of 135 residents out of 148 beds for occupancy of 91%.
- ❑ Per a 10-mile radius of Silver Hills, there are a total of 1,419 licensed skilled nursing beds of which per Medicare.gov website there were a total of 132 un-occupied beds for average occupancy of 90.7%.
- ❑ The growth in the population of Las Vegas and the social dynamics of an aging population creates a need for additional skilled nursing beds.
- ❑ The opening in northwest Las Vegas of Centennial Hills Hospital in 2007 will create further need for additional skilled nursing beds.

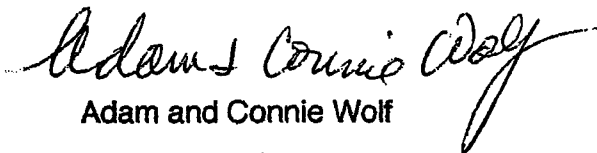
Even though my wife didn't participate in activities, Sharon Ward respected her wishes and was a reassuring smiling face to see everyday making so many people experience their
