MARK VINCENT, Director of Finance and Business Services, explained that the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (Metro) report was not complete and, therefore, requested another 90-day extension. VINCENT answered that a permanent license subject to reviews was granted because the ability to grant temporary licenses was exhausted and there were no areas of concern.
