**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

On April 5, 2006 City Council approved the award of an Engineering Design Services Agreement for Grand Central Parkway Widening to Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas, Inc. in the amount of \$606,325. The First Amendment includes additional design work and additional related design services not included in the original contract in the amount of \$359,565 which brings the total amount to \$965,890. Funding for this project is being provided by the Regional Transportation Commission and Union Park bonds.
