PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Councilman Gary Reese received a request for speed humps on Arthur Avenue between Searles Avenue and Owens Avenue. Studies conducted on Arthur Avenue showed that the 85th percentile speed was 35 mph and the volume of traffic was 718 vehicles per day. Arthur Avenue accumulated 13 points; a total of 40 points is needed to meet the criteria for speed humps. Arthur Avenue is not an emergency response route.
