PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This Advisory Committee was created by Assembly Bill 239 to provide information and advice to the RTC concerning the construction and maintenance of benches and shelters for passengers of public mass transportation. Members serve for a term of one year, with no limit to the number of terms that may be served, and unexpired terms must be filled. There is no City residency requirement. Mr. Furey has passed away and he was originally recommended by Councilman Brown with a term of office expiring on January 4, 2008. This item was abeyed at the City Council Meeting of July 11, 2007.
