Minutes:

The applicant was present.

JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, indicated that the recommended 90-day review was premature, because the business opened in July 2007. There was only one call for service for a perimeter check. In fairness to the licensee, he recommended a six-month extension of the temporary license, in order to better monitor the business now that it is open.

MS. NIXON concurred with the temporary licenses, but noted that she was under the impression that she would have to appear before the Council in October 2007, not in February 2008. She expressed concern about the extension. MR. DiFIORE replied that he did not feel 90 days would be sufficient time to assess the business. He felt that a six-month extension would be better.
