Minutes:
 TED RUSSELL, Las Vegas resident, said that people in public office become guilty of their success and prosperity. He noted that he is very impressed with the Historic Preservation Plan presented at this meeting.

TOM McGOWAN, Las Vegas resident, stated that he hopes the comments he makes will impact the conscience of the members of this Committee. The Constitution is the supreme law and its Fourteenth Amendment offers equal protection to all people. The City will pay attention to his comments when the facts come out for the CityRide buses. The City just acquired two additional buses with hydrogen technology at a cost of about \$500,000. These buses were immediately assigned to the Las Vegas Premium Outlet, which is already served by five buses, without first considering public comment or the Council's input. The government is contingent upon proper conduct and the protection and preservation of all its citizens. He opined that, if the constitution were to cease to exist, the rights of the people would still be guaranteed.

At the request of COUNCILMAN BARLOW, CHRISTOPHER WILSON, Ward 5 student intern, introduced himself. He is a senior at UNLV, and he said that he is enjoying all the knowledge he is acquiring through his internship.
