Regarding affordable housing, TODD FARLOW, 240 North 19th Street, encouraged the Commissioners to look at smaller stand-alone projects rather than large, multi-story developments and gave several examples within the City.

TOM McGOWAN, Las Vegas resident, announced that the cancellation of a bus route violates the 14th Amendment and a complaint will be filed with the US Attorney General.

JEFF WELLS, Las Vegas resident, suggested using vacant buildings around the City to house the homeless.

IVO PLECKO, founder of Piter's Foundation, asked the Commissioners for assistance in implementing his solution to the homeless problem and submitted his proposal for the record. CHAIRMAN DAVENPORT explained that the Commissioners had no authority in that matter.
