TODD MARS, 3017 Campbell Circle, on behalf of the applicant, stated that based on the space available and the ease of construction, the design was selected for its appeal and architectural elevations.

COMMISSIONER EVANS asked whether the variance would have an impact on anyone.

COMMISSIONER STAINMAN acknowledged the letters from adjacent neighbors but pointed out that because of the density of trees, the property would be well shielded.
