

FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL INTERLOCAL CONTRACT
DISCOVERY LANE, GRAND CENTRAL PARKWAY TO
MARTIN L KING BOULEVARD

THIS FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL INTERLOCAL CONTRACT, made and entered into this 19TH day of September, 2007 by and between the CITY OF LAS VEGAS, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "CITY" and the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada hereinafter referred to as "RTC".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 373 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, a Project to design, purchase right-of-way, perform construction inspection and construct roadway improvements for Discovery Lane, Grand Central Parkway to Martin L. King Boulevard, which is totally within the CITY, has been approved by the Regional Transportation Commission.

WHEREAS, the parties have executed an Interlocal Contract dated July 11, 2002 and Supplemental Interlocal Contracts on April 14, 2005, August 11, 2005, May 18, 2006 for design, construction, and right-of-way of Discovery Lane, Grand Central Parkway to Martin L. King Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the CITY wishes to increase funding for right-of-way acquisition.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants, conditions, agreements, and promises of the parties hereto, the RTC authorizes the CITY to proceed with the PROJECT as it is mutually understood and agrees as follows.

SECTION II- PROJECT COSTS shall be revised to read as follows:

SECTION II - PROJECT COSTS

The RTC agrees to provide funding for project costs according to Section 6.1 REIMBURSEMENT COSTS of the Policies and Procedures Manual of the RTC within the limits specified below:

1. The total cost for engineering design, contract administration, surveying, inspection, testing, right-of-way engineering, right-of-way negotiations and acquisition, utility relocation and construction shall not exceed \$5,725,000 which includes all of the above items.
2. The City will be granted a revised "Authorization to Proceed" for Engineering at a cost not to exceed \$650,000, Right-of-Way Other cost not to exceed \$81,000, Right-of-Way Acquisition at a cost not to exceed \$2,994,000 and Construction at a cost not to exceed \$2,000,000 at the time written Authorization to Proceed is received from the RTC.
3. A written request must be made to the RTC and a supplemental interlocal contract approved to allow exceptions to the adopted policies and procedures of the RTC or the amount noted above prior to payment of any additional funds.


All other terms of the interlocal contract dated July 11, 2002 and Supplemental Interlocal Contracts dated April 14, 2005, August 11, 2005, February 9, 2006 and 4/12/07 shall remain unchanged.

Project: Discovery Drive – Grand Central to Martin L. King

Funding: Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada

Background: Construction was substantially completed on February 27, 2007

Existing Conditions: Discovery Drive did not previously exist between Grand Central Parkway and Martin L. King Boulevard.

Proposed Improvements:

Roadway Improvements: Construct (4) lanes of roadway improvements with curb, gutter, sidewalk and streetlights between Grand Central Parkway and Martin L. King Boulevard.

Right-of-Way: The right-of-way width will be 80-feet.

Traffic Signals: A new traffic signal will be constructed at Casino Center and Charleston Boulevard.

Drainage Improvements: New storm drain drop inlets will be constructed with the project.

Sanitary Sewer: An existing sanitary sewer will be replaced with the project.
